Ideas of what to include in your sketchbook/pages:


- Collages of some images (printed/magazine/newspaper)

 - Poems or other text/data you have found
 - Experiments in different media/materials

The size is up to you ...as big or small as you wish to work (most of my sketchbooks are smaller than A4 as that's how I prefer to work)...you may use a mix of found papers or cut up packaging ...be creative but remember that any drawings need to be worked into at the same standard or higher than your GCSE work.
