

Mathematics Teacher

We are seeking to appoint an enthusiastic, creative and committed teacher to join a successful department. An ability to work with others and communicate effectively is therefore extremely important. The successful candidate will be expected to deliver high quality lessons, exhibit a passion for their subject and establish good working relationships with the students.

Mathematics students follow our own bespoke two-year curriculum in KS3 before starting the Mathematics GCSE (Edexcel) in Year 9. Many students choose to study Mathematics in the Sixth form, where they follow the Edexcel A Level course and additionally, we do offer Further Mathematics to a small number of students; an ability and willingness to contribute to courses at Key Stage 3 and GCSE are essential. There will be opportunities to teach Sixth Form A Level work for suitable candidates.

Mathematics is taught in its own suite of rooms comprising of an open-plan Learning Base (which can accommodate three teaching groups), a partitioned Learning Base (which accommodates three teaching groups) and four study rooms. All these teaching areas are equipped with electronic whiteboard with access to the internet and school network. We have access to several online resources to enhance the teaching of Mathematics including the online curriculum.

We also run an extensive Session 3 programme after school where students can receive additional support with their learning or take part in subject related activities such as the UKMT individual or team challenges.

Key aspects of the job are

- To assist in the planning & delivery of the KS3 and KS4 Mathematics curriculum
- To thoroughly prepare students for external examinations
- To monitor student progress and provide personalised verbal & written feedback
- To collaborate with other staff within the Thomas Telford family of schools to plan and provide enrichment opportunities within the subject
